

ARC/PLC PROVISIONS 2019-2023

Program Options

- Reauthorized Price Loss Coverage (PLC)
 Price Based selected by Base Crop on the farm
- Reauthorized Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC)
 Revenue Based
 - ARC-CO County Yield Level
 - by Base Crop on the farm
 - ARC-IC Individual/Farm Yield Level
 - by FARM for all Base Crops



Program Signup Process

- Yield Update: An Owner can Update PLC
 Yields. (October of 2019 September 30, 2020)
- Election: Election of PLC, ARC-CO or ARC-IC can be completed prior to yield updates.
 (September of 2019 March 15, 2020 for 2019)
- 3. Enrollment: Once Election has been completed then Enrollment takes place.

(September of 2019 – March 15, 2020 for 2019)



1. PLC Yield Update Process

Allows an **OWNER** a **one-time** decision to update the farm's PLC yield for **2020** on a commodity by commodity basis.

Operator or Owners may initiate this process

- > Yield update is effective for 2020 (through the life of the Farm Bill); not retroactive to 2019.
- The updated PLC yield is equal to 90% of each covered commodity's 2013 2017 average yield. Simple average of the years the crop is planted, multiplied by a National Ratio.
- ➤ If the yield in any of these years (2013 2017) is less than 75% of the county yield, then 75% of the 2013 2017 county yield will be substituted for that year.

Note: The Yield Update option is available PER Crop for producers and farms regardless of program election – PLC/ARC-CO/ARC-IC.



PLC Yield Update:

Operators on the farm will likely have the yield data and can initiate the yield update process, however:

At least **ONE** owner Must sign the CCC-867 Form.

RMA yield Data can be used.

If FSA receives conflicting yield update from another owner, owners will be required to resolve their dispute providing CCC with written evidence of the dispute resolution by the end of the yield update period.

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PLC Yield Update

- ☐ The PLC yield update process may be requested and completed <u>regardless of program election</u> made for the base crop on the farm.
- ☐ The PLC yield update/request is a one-time opportunity for program year 2020.
- ☐ The PLC yield may be used in future Farm Bills, depending on the regulations in those bills.



PROGRAM ELECTION

ARC/PLC Election Process

ALL <u>Producer(s)</u> with an interest in cropland on the farm will make the election decision.


Owners do not make the election decision, unless they are considered a Producer, having an interest in cropland on the farm. This would not include owners with an interest in CRP.

- 2019 Election Deadline March 15, 2020.
- □ Election locked in for 2019 and 2020.
- Each year 2021-2023, producers will have the opportunity to "change" the election on the farm.
- Failure to make a 2019 election by March 15, 2020 will result in a default to the current election on the farm (2014-2018) and NO payment issued for 2019.



PLC, ARC-CO, ARC-IC Election

- Elections of PLC or ARC-CO are made on a covered commodity by covered commodity basis (Base Crops) on the farm.
- Election of ARC-IC, all covered commodity base acres on the farm have elected ARC-IC.







PRICE LOSS COVERAGE (PLC)

Price Loss Coverage (PLC)

- Payments issued when
 Effective Price is less than
 Effective Reference Price
- Payments issued on 85% of the base acres of the covered commodity
- May be elected by base crop
- May be combined with ARC-CO or RMA's SCO
- Payments are made regardless of planting of covered commodity

- Effective Price = higher of Marketing Year Average Price (MYA) or the National Loan Rate for the Crop
- □ Effective Reference Price =
 the lesser of: 115% of the
 reference price OR the
 greater of: the Reference
 Price OR 85% of the 5year Olympic Ave of the
 MYA Price



Reference Price/National Loan Rate

AGRICULTURAL RISK COVERAGE (ARC) - COUNTY

Ag Risk Coverage – County (ARC-CO)

- Payments made when the ARC-CO Actual Revenue is <u>less than</u> the ARC-CO Guarantee (86% Benchmark) for a covered commodity.
 - County "Yield" data is used, not individual/producer farm data.
- The payment rate can be no higher than 10% of the ARC-CO Benchmark Revenue for the covered commodity.
- Payments made on 85% of base acres of the covered commodity.
- Payments are made regardless of the planting of the covered commodity.
- Election may be made by covered commodity (base crop) on the farm.



ARC-County

"NEW" under 2018 Farm Bill:

- ARC-CO Benchmark Revenue, Guarantee will be based on "PHYSICAL LOCATION" of the tract and farm.
- ARC-CO Actual Crop Revenue will also be based on "PHYSICAL LOCATION" of the tract and farm.

NOTE: 2014 Farm Bill, ARC-CO revenue calculations were based on "Administrative County" of the farm.

Exception, there was a "waiver of administrative county" for 2014 & 2015, if requested by all producers on the farm.



ARC-County

ARC-CO Yields will be established using the following data:



- RMA yield data for the county where the data is available
 - > For Indiana, the majority of counties have RMA yield data available for corn and soybeans.
 - Benchmark yields will include lag year, so for 2019, the benchmark years will be 2013-2017.



- NASS yield data available for State Committee review when RMA yield data is not available.
- No RMA or NASS yield data, then State Committee will use best available data to establish the yield.



ARC-CO Example continued...

Calculate the Actual Crop Revenue:

(County Example)

Corn: $$3.60 \times 180 = 648

Soya: $$8.50 \times 50 = 425

Crop	Benchmark County Revenue	ARC County Guarantee	Payment Cap
Corn	\$759.98	\$653.58	\$76/A
Soybeans	\$541.21	\$465.44	\$54.12/A

Is there a loss?

Corn: \$653.58 - \$648 = \$5.58

Soya: \$465.44 - \$425 = \$40.44



Does the loss exceed the payment cap (10%) for each crop?

Calculate the Payment:

Corn: $85\% \times 150 \times $5.58 \times 100\% = 711.45

Soya: $85\% \times 150 \times 40.44 \times 100\% = \$5,156$

Total Farm Payment = \$5,867.55



AGRICULTURAL RISK COVERAGE (ARC) - INDIVIDUAL

Ag Risk Coverage – Individual (ARC-IC)

- Payments are made when the ARC-IC Actual Revenue is <u>less than</u> the ARC-IC Guarantee (86% Benchmark) for ALL covered commodities (base crops) on ALL farms enrolled in ARC-IC in the state for the producer.
- The payment rate is the difference in the ARC-IC Guarantee and the ARC-IC Actual Revenue, but can be no higher than 10% of the ARC-IC Benchmark Revenue for all covered commodities on the farm.
- Payments made on 65% of total base acres on the farm.
- Election is by FARM.



ARC-IC & Prevent Plant (100%)

- Producers who experienced 100% Prevent Plant (PP) of all covered commodities on the farm in 2019 should review the ARC-IC program for details.
- > 100% Prevent Plant acres are considered "planted" for FSA programs under the ARC-IC program. This will result in a zero actual year yield & revenue for 2019.
- The ARCPLC Election is binding for 2019 and 2020. However, elections can be changed for 2021-2023 by producers on the farm.



ARC-IC 2019 100 % PP Farm Example

Farm #1: 100% Prevent Plant Corn with <u>NO</u> other covered commodity planted on the farm.

Corn: Benchmark Revenue = \$849.80

Guarantee (86%) = \$730.83

Actual Revenue (O Yield) = \$0.00

\$730.83 - \$0.00 = \$730.83 loss

10% CAP Benchmark Revenue = \$84.98/acre

ARC-IC payment Calculation:

300 Base Acres X 65% X \$84.98 = \$16,571



3. ARC/PLC Enrollment Process

2019 Election & Enrollment are completed on the same form, CCC-866 for PLC, ARC-CO or CCC-862 for ARC-IC.

- □ 2019 Election Deadline is March 15, 2020.
- 2019 Enrollment deadline is March 15, 2020.
- □ 2020 Enrollment deadline is June 30, 2020.
- 2019 & 2020 program years can be completed simultaneously in the same visit to the county office.
- Enrollment is an annual process.
- Producers may participate or not participate year by year.
- Zero share owner signatures are NOT required for annual Enrollment.
